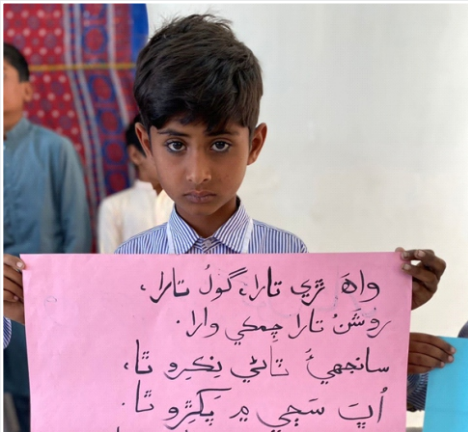
MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

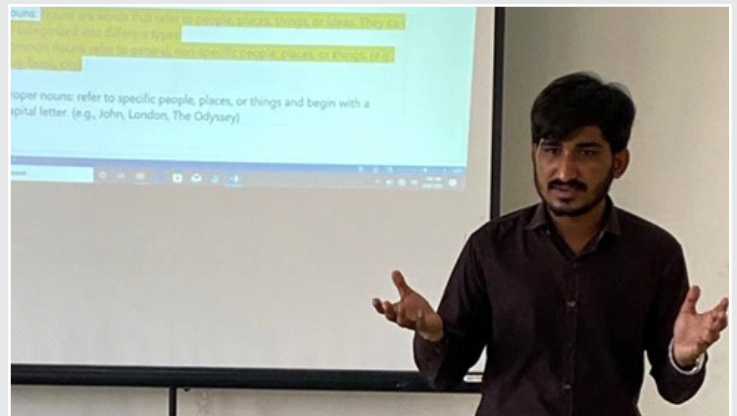
